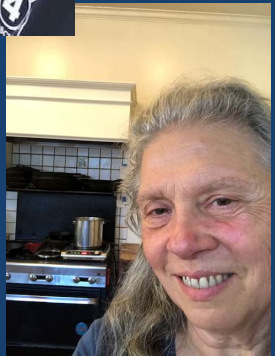

Dylos Downloading

Prior to Download for the 1st Time

- Set-up a folder on your computer for downloads.
- Save the link for the Dylos uploads in your browser (Sharefile)
- Write the room location for “I”, “O” or “R” on each Dylos.
- Load the Trendnet Driver AND
- Follow directions to download Putty (Windows) or ZOC (Mac)
 - (refer to **GREEN** Dylos instructions/ **White** Mac instructions)
- Gather Dylos directions, Dylos, computer, and Trendnet cord

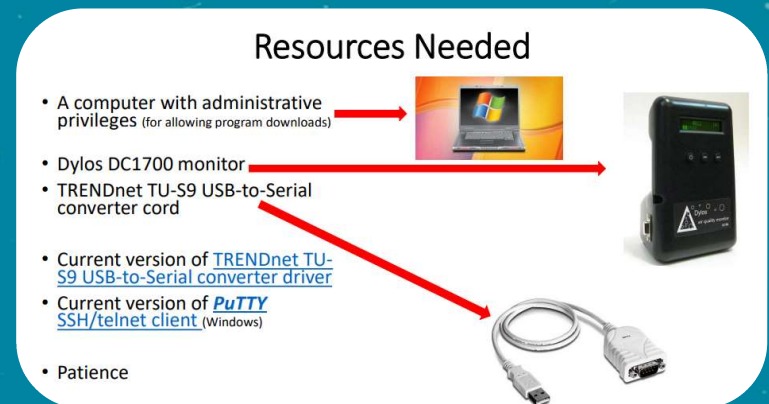

Uploading Files: File Naming

Example (for Dylos downloads): BLT_I_D035_04-15-21_LivingRoom

- **3-digit ID**
 - Example: 'BLT', find yours on your user agreement
- **Equipment location code**
 - Indoor, Outdoor, Roamer
 - 'R' is usually bedroom in homes or conference room in a workplace
 - NOTE: 'S' stands for special when there is a 4th Dylos
- **Equipment ID**
 - D035 - found on the label on the front of the Dylos
- **Date** (month-day-year) each 2 digits = 07-15-21
- **Room name** (if inside - living room, office, library for example)
- Each section separated with an underscore “_”



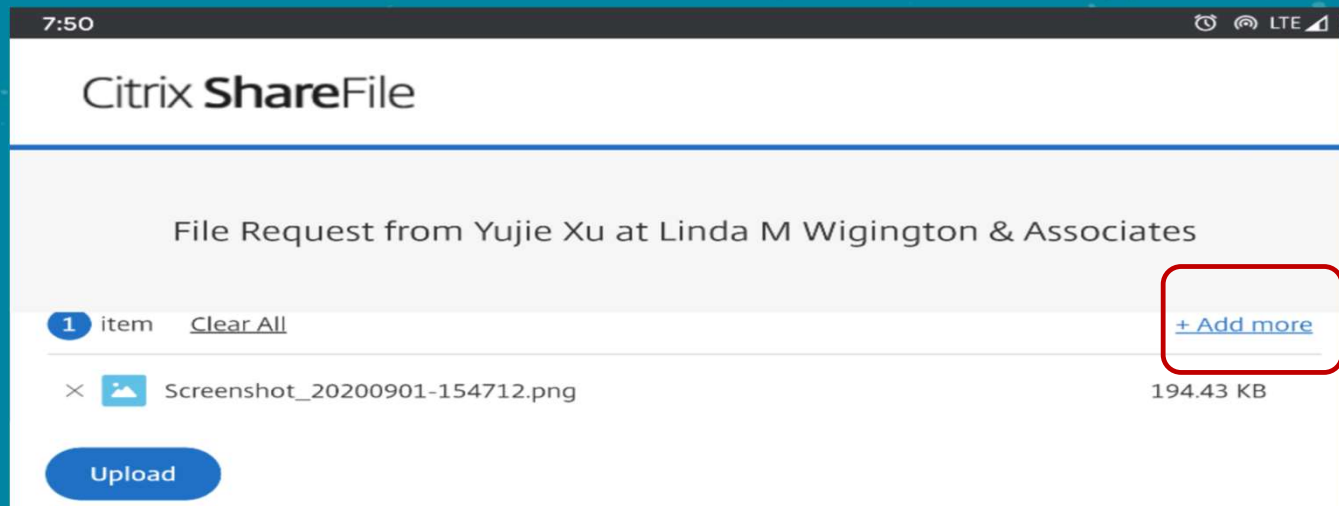

Next Steps after Downloading

Checking the File

1. **Can you find file on your computer?**
2. **Is the file name correct?.**
 1. Name correct = ID, Dylos location (I, R, O, or S), dates, room name
 2. File name format correct
3. **Is the content complete?**
 1. File size OK (usually 200-350 KB)
 2. Open file to make sure start date & end dates are correct.

Clearing the Data

1. After file confirmed to be correct & complete “Clear History” (push middle button repeatedly, then right button)
2. Go back to “Continuous” mode – bouncing reading



Dylos Troubleshooting: Battery Charging



Battery
Charge
Level

To Charge:

- Plug in monitor
- Turn monitor OFF
- Make sure battery button on



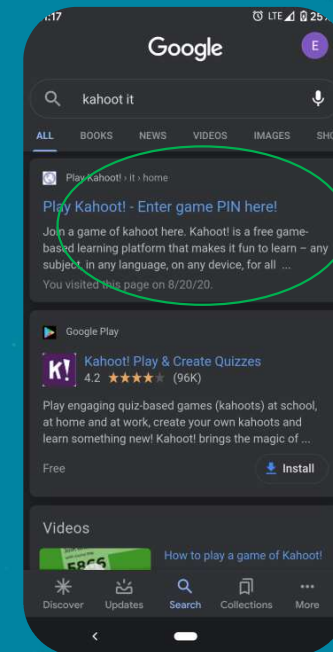
More reliable with 3 or 4 bars; at most lasts 2-3 hours when not plugged in

Does not charge automatically!

One More ...

- Sometimes the Dylos charges then mysteriously says “low battery”.
- If you know they were just fully charged – ignore & proceed.





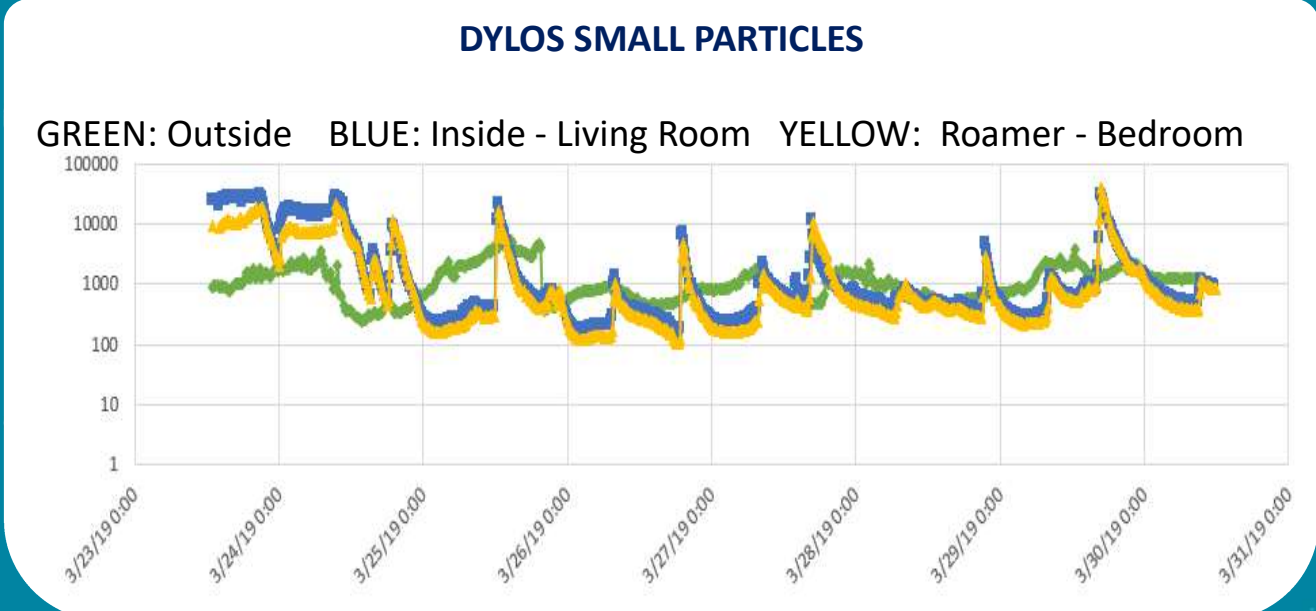
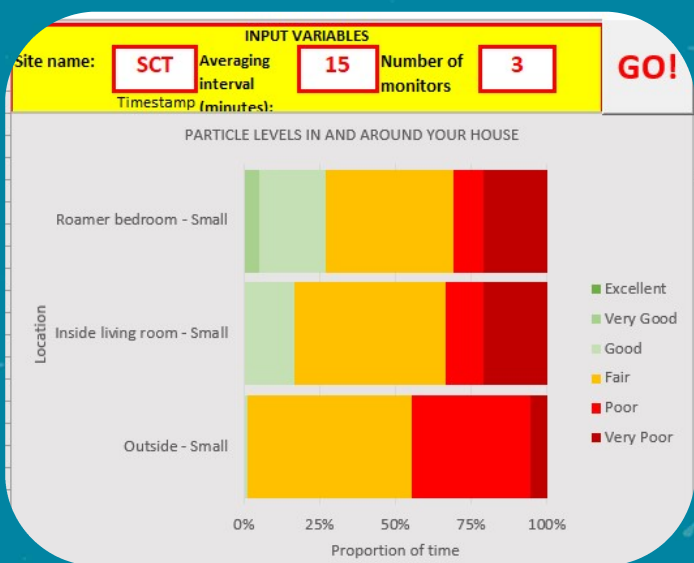

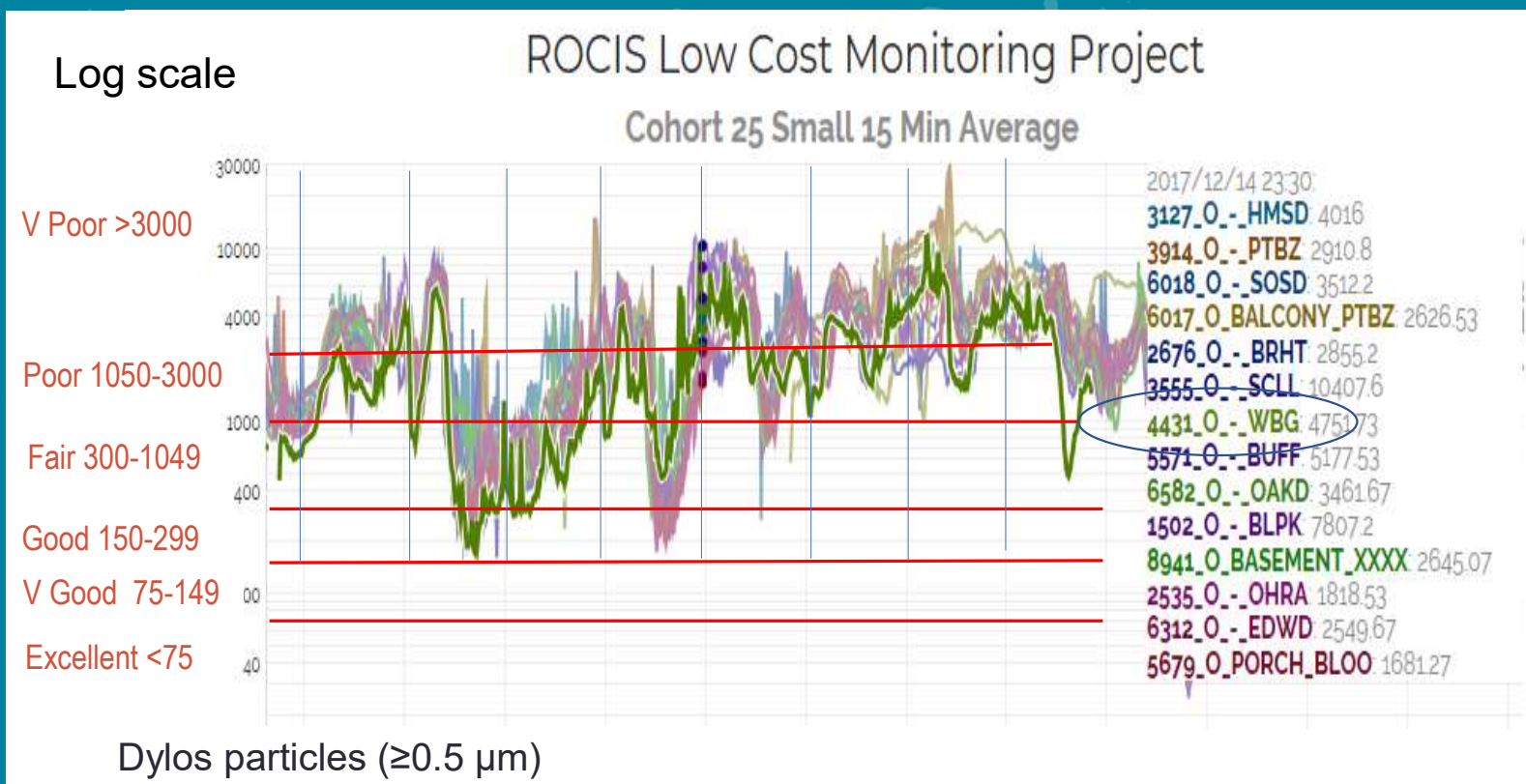
